## **Notes for Similarity Comparison for Degree Theses/Dissertations**

- 1. In Academic Affairs Meetings, the Office of Academic Affairs has highlighted the importance of each program communicating with graduate students about their obligation to comply with academic ethics. The advisor and department (program) shall assess the originality of theses/dissertations by using similarity comparisons to ensure that texts are free from plagiarism. As per the university's Regulations for Doctoral and Master's Degree Examinations, graduate students who are suspected of plagiarism, hiring someone to write their work, or cheating on their theses/dissertations (including substituting works or exhibitions in place of theses/dissertations or associated reports) shall be subject to review by the Academic Ethics Violation Review Committee for Degree Theses/Dissertations. Their advisors shall also be reviewed through a Faculty Evaluation Committee Meeting at their department of employment.
- 2. In the Degree Thesis/Dissertation Examination Application Forms submitted to the Office of Academic Affairs by each program, the Academic Ethics Statements of some articles indicated that these articles demonstrated some concern for plagiarism despite exhibiting a relatively low level of similarity with other existing articles. As shown in the appendix, one article had an overall similarity of 19%, and 4% of its content was similar to that of another article; in addition, 598 words were identical with those in other articles but lack appropriate citations.
- 3. For all graduate students applying for a thesis/dissertation examination:
  - (1) Please attach a Paper Plagiarism Verify System similarity report, a Symskan similar articles and similar paragraphs comparison report (until May 31, 2022), or an iThenticate similarity percentage report (as shown in the figure below) and relevant documents.
  - (2) In the "The similarity report indicates no violation of academic ethics in the thesis/dissertation. Please specify:" field, please provide the statement: The similarity percentage is \*\*%, and the report shows no sign of violation against academic ethics.
  - (3) Depending on the results of similarity reports, students and their advisors shall assess the need to revise their theses/dissertations before submission, and the college and department shall perform a rigorous review before approving submissions.
